

Connect to eduroam via Android

When setting up eduroam on Android devices, to ensure a secure connection, it is advisable to use the **eduroam CAT (Configuration Assistant Tool)** application available from the Google Play Store.

If the eduroam CAT application cannot be used, you should be able to set up the connection in the following way.

1. Select your Android device's settings.
2. Access the Wi-Fi settings.
3. Ensure Wi-Fi is turned on.
4. Select **eduroam** from the list of available networks.
5. When prompted for connection details, provide the following details for your device:

Android (version 7 or higher)

- **EAP method:** "PEAP"
- **Phase 2 Authentication:** "MSCHAPV2"
- **CA Certificate:** "Use system certificates"
- **Domain:** "nrc.ac.uk"
- **Identity:** Network Username@nrc.ac.uk
- **Anonymous Identity:** <leave blank>
- **Password:** Network password

Android (earlier versions)

- **EAP:** "PEAP"
- **Phase 2 Authentication:** "MSCHAPV2"
- **CA Certificate:** "Unspecified"
- **User certificate:** "Unspecified"
- **Identity:** Network Username@nrc.ac.uk
- **Anonymous Identity:** <leave blank>
- **Password:** Network password

6. Select **Connect**. You should then be connected to the **eduroam** network.
