### About this Course

This course provides an alternative route for mature students wishing to apply for entry to higher education. It prepares those without traditional qualifications to study at university and improve their career prospects. It is a modularised course and is set at A level standard. The modularised structure offers great flexibility to allow you to fit your study around your commitments. There are a variety of internal assessments including essays, reports, case studies and projects. All modules have an examination with the exception of Statistical Research with ICT and E-business which are examined by coursework only.
