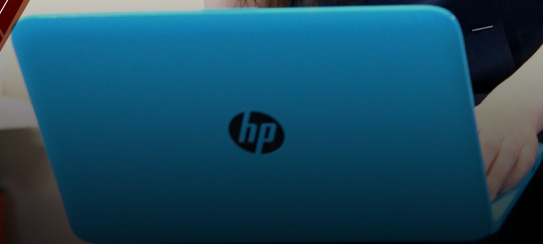

On completing this course you will be able to apply for managerial posts in Adult residential or domiciliary services.

Entry conditions

You must be aged 18 years of age or over and be employed in a care role either in a full-time, part-time or voluntary capacity with evidence of advanced practice expertise. All applicants will be subject to a successful interview.



About this Course

This professional qualification is aimed at providing those who are responsible for running a facility that provides services for adults. It will give you the opportunity to build both managerial and care skills whilst achieving a recognised Level 5 vocational qualification. There are two pathways that you can select from to specialise in - adults' residential management or adult care. You will complete a portfolio of evidence in the form of written statements, reflective accounts and undertake observations within your work environment. It is the accepted qualification for registration and regulation in accordance with NISCC and RQIA guidance.
